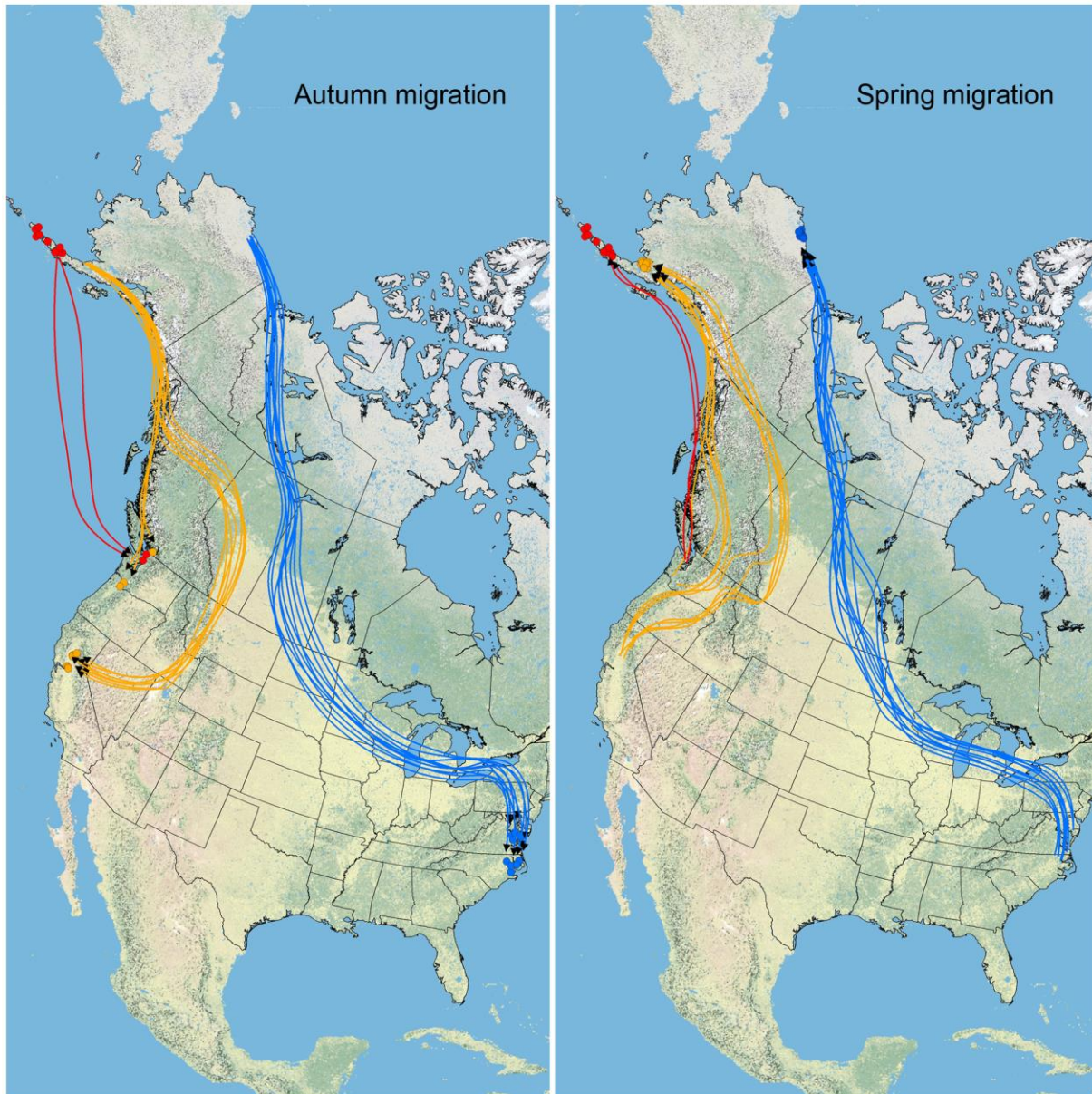


Tundra Swan migration routes in North America
